Walking to Campus

• Students must wait for crossing guard OK before crossing the street.

Drop-off/

Pick-un Route

- Students should look before crossing large driveways.
- Teach your students how to safely cross the street:
 Stop at the curb.
 - Look left, right, and left again.
 - Ask, "Is it safe to cross?"
 - If a car comes, start over.
 - If a car stops for you, make eye contact with the driver to make sure they see you.
- Tell your students to walk, never run, across the street.

Biking to Campus

- Students always need to wear a helmet. It's the law!
- Students riding on the sidewalk should let walkers know that they are behind them. Leave plenty of room when passing.
- Students must walk their bike when in a crosswalk.
- Students should only park their bike in the bike racks.



Johnson Park Elementary Dropoff/Pick-up Procedures

For the safety of all children, please follow the drop-off procedures:

Be a Courteous Driver

- Be alert for students walking and biking to school. They are more likely to dart out into the street.
- Always drive 25 MPH or less around the school during school travel times.
- **Do not** stop in or block visibility of crosswalks.
- **Do not** use cellular devices while driving in a school zone.
- **Do not** block visibility or access to the parking lot.

Drop-Off & Pick-Up Procedures

- The **blue** route is available for drop-off and pick-up.
- Pull all the way forward in the loading/unloading area along the curb. **Do not** leave your vehicle. If you need to park, use the designated parking spaces.
- **Do not** stop at a crosswalk and allow your children to exit the vehicle. It is not safe and it could result in a child being injured by another vehicle.
- Please note, when exiting the parking lot, the exit is a **RIGHT TURN ONLY**. Visibility is limited and causes unnecessary congestion if drivers make a left turn.

Park and Walk to Campus

• To avoid congestion, there are many places you can park and walk with your student to school including residential side streets such as Lever Ave and Larson St. as shown above.
